

<u>Secretary's Report:</u> Secretaries report was read by members. Eric moved to accept the minutes; Brian seconded. Motion passed.

<u>Treasurer Report:</u> Bob reported all bills current. Checking account balance is \$38,714.34. Mark moved to accept the report, Doug seconded. Motion passed.

<u>Deacon's Report:</u> Doug reported average attendance of 104 for the month. The Communion count was 91 and 87 with an average of 89. Total giving is \$12,809.66 for the month, with yearly giving of \$137,253.04. This was for a total of 4 Sundays.

Trustee's Report: Michele still waiting for written confirmation from Mid State on start date in the Spring.

Elder's Report: Mark is working in conjunction with Thrivent for our adopt a family recipient this year. It will be for the Ronny Wagner family. There son has had extensive brain surgery and has many bills. It will be used for them and to help with transportation expenses. The first Sunday in December the loose offering will be going towards the adopt a family fund instead of a meal this year. Michele made a motion for the loose offering on December 1st to go towards the adopt a family. Bob seconded. Motion passed.

<u>Pastor's Report:</u> Pastor had a log of his hours with him for council members to look at. There will be a Christmas open house at Pastor and Karen's home on December 15th from 3-7pm.
