

Pastor Scherner and Susie Sutherland were also present. Eric will present devotions next month.

<u>Secretary's Report:</u> Ben moved to accept the minutes as presented. Bob seconded. Motion passed.

<u>Treasurer's Report:</u> Tim reported that all bills are current. The checking account balance is \$56,941. Eric moved to accept the Treasurer's Report. Mark seconded. Motion passed.

<u>Deacon's Report:</u> Sam reported an average attendance of 109 for the month. The communion count was 100. Attendance for the Christmas Eve services was 161 and 94. The communion count was 143. The total giving for the month was \$21,058, with \$14,736 current giving. Total giving for the year was \$190,861.
